SPEAKER: Mike Williams, MSc, BEng, LEED AP BD+C | CDML - Director



Mike Williams has spent the latter part of his career in the field of Sustainability. Mike worked as a Project Manager with Green Building Services Inc. of Portland, Oregon, and more recently as an entrepreneur and one of 2 founding principals of ECO3, a sustainability consulting firm which joined forces with the renowned multidisciplinary engineering firm, CDML in 2011. In Mike's current position as the Director of Sustainability Services at CDML, Mike oversees projects in pursuit of sustainability objectives such as: LEED certification, Toronto Green Standard compliance, Green House Gas reductions and energy efficiency targets.

Mike's recently completed work includes "CanmetMATERIALS Lab", a 16,000 m² laboratory and office space project targeting LEED Platinum certification! One of the goals for this project was a 75% reduction in energy cost through investments in renewable energy and other related design initiatives. Mike will discuss CanMET in detail with particular emphasis on the Integrated Design Process (IDP), which is becoming common in the industry through the green building movement. The session will not only highlight the resulting success stories but will also share the "lessons learned". Mike holds a BEng in Civil Engineering from Western University in London, Ontario, and an MSc in Ecotechnology & Sustainable Development from Mittuniversitetet in Östersund, Sweden.
